Instructions

This printable is designed to to be printed on 8.5x11 inch standard sized paper.

If you have a printer that will print on the back side of the paper, insert regular paper and instruct you printer to print page 1 on the front and page 2 on on the back.

If easier, just print pages 1 and 2 and glue the backs together. The references for the verse card should align with the corresponding verse.

NOTE: If you have heavier paper, you can place a sheet of heavy paper between the two pages to have sturdier verse cards
